Supplies do not have to be exact the same brand as what is listed (when listed), but you will need something similar to the colors, compression and thickness. After looking around your space you might be surprised how many items you already have access to. **Paint:** Any of the following paints will work, but I will be using acrylic. Don't purchase anything new if you already have these items at home.

- Acrylic – Blick Acrylic
- Gouache
- Watercolor
- Tempera

#### Colors:

- Black
- White - Titanium
- **R** – Cadmium Red medium
- **Y** – Cadmium Yellow Deep or Hansa Yellow Deep
- **B** – Ultramarine Blue
- **C** - Phthalo Blue
- **M** - Quinacridone Red or Viridian

- Y - Lemon Yellow or Cadmium Yellow

#### **Computer Program:**

- Adobe Creative Cloud
- Other free programs will work, as long as you can create shapes and use the color picker sliders.

#### **Paper:**

- Colored paper – Color Aid brand is preferred.
- Cardboard, canvas, illustration boards, surfaces to paint on (several)
- Black paper (just a few sheets. May come with colored paper)
- Construction paper
- Junk mail: Look at the post office in their recycling
- Magazines
- Grid paper
- Swatch samples from a paint store. They are free. Get as many as you can.
- Corrugated cardboard

#### **Other Items:**

- Ruler
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Markers or colored pencils
- Sponges
- Colored inks (optional)
- Pastels (optional)
- Elmer's Glue
- Wood (optional for mixed media pieces)
