## Wix Website Check Point 1

Each student is required to have a digital portfolio of their work (Essential Objective 9). You will be using <u>Wix.com</u> to display all of your digital designs. I have used Wix.com for my website design for years and have found it incredibly easy to use. Wix.com also follows the same format using similar tools and navigation as the Adobe programs.

The goal is to have a complete portfolio by the end of this class. Please follow the linked tutorial and personalize your Wix.com site. You will post a link to your site in the corresponding forum.

## Directions:

- Follow the link: How to Build a Website with Wix.com and create a site. Use your school email address unless you would like to keep this beyond school.
- o I encourage you to use a template unless you have experience designing websites. This shouldn't be a time-consuming endeavor.
- Create a welcome or Home page with an about me section. Introduce yourself.
- o Create a portfolio page. Here you will house all of your designs from this course
- o Include your Photoshop designs so far in this course
- Include a description with each design. You know what it is, but someone who hasn't been in this course may not know what it is.
- Create a Contact page. You do not have to use real contact information unless you want to.

We will revisit your portfolio two more times this semester, so it is not expected that your website be complete at this time. You are expected to have your Photoshop assignments on your *Portfolio* page. The *Home* page and *contact* page can be a work in progress.
